

## Tips for dealing with pests:

- 1. Ensure garbage is stored in a sealed container.
- 2. Remove all food sources for pests. Food sources include bird feeders, pet food, backyard composter, fallen apples from apple trees, garbage & green cart compost.
- 3. Backyard compost piles can be a problem as a source of food if the food is not buried in yard waste. Make sure only fruits & vegetables are in backyard compost piles. No fats, meat, fish, bread, or grain products are to be put in backyard compost.
- 4. We recommend continuing to place food scraps (compost) in the supplied green cart. If rats are getting into the green cart it will be apparent by chew holes.

## Tips to keep pests out of your green compost cart:

- 1. Add lots of yard waste to the cart (or wrap food in newspaper) to help absorb smells. If the vent holes at bottom have been chewed through Stuff a rag soaked in bleach in the vent hole (make sure it stays affixed to the cart) or stuff steel wool in the hole.

- 3. Freeze smelly food scraps (meat, fish) until collection day.
- 4. Rinse your cart after collection day with detergent (or a small amount of bleach about five percent and then add water).
