Please find below questions and answers for addendum #1.

- Q1. Are we able to work during regular business hours? Are there any noise restrictions?
- A1. Work during business hours is permitted. High noise emitting work (grinding, etc.) in the fitness area will need to be scheduled around class scheduling in the adjacent group fitness room.
- Q2. Will areas like the gym where demolition and new work is being done be closed to the public?
- A2. We will close that specific section of the fitness center while demo and other work in that area is completed. We would like an estimate of how long it would need to be closed so we can plan accordingly.
- Q3. Existing supply ducts in basement are spec'd to be thermally insulated but are inaccessible above existing heating lines/uptight to walls and have cabling fastened to them. Please advise.
- A3. Insulating of supply air ductwork in basement area is not required and to be removed from contract.
- Q4. Does existing equipment being removed get turned over to the City of Saint John or Disposed or by Mechanical Contractor?
- A4. Disposed of by mechanical contractor. Confirm with the City of Saint John for right of first refusal prior to disposing of equipment.
- Q5. What is the substantial completion date of the project?
- A5. March 31st, 2023
