Division 2 – Submission of Tender

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Saint John is implementing adjustments to the tender submission procedure as follows:

Section 2.6.01 Location of Tender Box for the Submission of Tender

175 Rothesay Avenue, Saint John, New Brunswick

The tender box will be available at the main building entrance for submission of tenders by the Tenderer between the hours of 9:30 am and 2:30:00 pm only on the above tender closing date. Tenderers shall maintain physical distancing from others when depositing their tender in the tender box.

There will not be a public tender opening. Registered Bidders will receive an email invitation to view the Tender Opening using Microsoft Teams software. Email invitations will be sent to the address provided on the Official Bidder’s List. The Tender Opening Committee will conduct the evaluation of the tenders and Compliant tenders will be included in the summary of bids on the City’s Tenders & Proposals website within 1 business day following the tender closing.

ADDITION TO DIVISION 4 - FORM OF TENDER

Please see the following responses to questions received:

Q1: Are four new traffic signs required or three?

A1: *Four new traffic signs are required, added is a No Parking Left Arrow Sign (300 mm x 300 mm); this sign to replace a sign noted on the drawings as re-use. This item in Division 4, Section 4.5 (Schedule of Quantities and Unit Prices) in the Contract Specifications remains unchanged.*

Q2: Will there be a fuel adjustment for this contract?

A2: *Please refer to Division 3 - Particular Specifications, Section 3.1.38 (Fuel Adjustment Clause).*

Q3: Will the current DTI rental rates be honored for this contract?

A3: *Please refer to Division 3 - Particular Specifications, Section 3.1.36 (Changes in the Work).*

Q4: Will there be a unit for flowable fill?

A4: *Insert the attached Sheet 5 of 17 (Addendum #1), in Division 4, Section 4.5 (Schedule of Quantities and Unit Prices) in the Contract Specifications.*
