Job Summary

This position involves autobody repair, accident damage assessment, parts ordering and installation, paint preparation and finish coating duties.

Principle Duties Will Include

Examines Transit vehicles, buses and other equipment assigned to body-paint shop under work order. Determines the extent of repairs necessary to satisfactorily correct problem; estimates probable cost of completed job.

Repair damaged, rusted, and corroded parts and surfaces and interior finishing of Transit vehicles, buses, and other equipment to improve lifespan, value, safety, and appearance.

Removes upholstery, panels, and accessories to enter dented area and pounds opposite surface with a hammer against dolly (body iron) to remove crumples in metal. Fills depressions with plastic filler compound. Files, grinds, sands, and buffs hardened surface using power and hand tools.

Replaces parts damaged beyond repair (i.e., fenders, panels, bumpers, grilles, trunk, and hood lids etc.) using wrenches and cutting torch. Affixes new items by bolting, gluing or welding them into position.

Applies primer coat and sands surface smooth using abrasives. Mixes paints and paints surface of vehicle after having taped down portions to be avoided (i.e., windows, chrome, lights etc.)

Inspects, cleans, and repairs interior furnishing such as floor coverings, seats, upholstery, headlining's, armrests etc. Replaces windshields, side windows, etc. and performs related work as may be required or assigned.

Orders materials, parts and supplies required for trade work.
